

Summer Camp

Summer camp has begun, and we are well on our way. Parents, please be mindful of the following:

- Summer Camp is governed by the State and the State requires each child be escorted into the Center by an adult and signed in and out each day. (This also lets you know someone is there to actually receive your child or if something is going on that you should know about.)
- We want the children to have fun! But please let your children know that having fun does not mean that they should be disrespectful of the adults and of the Center's property.
- Having well-behaved children who listen to teacher directions keeps us all safe.
- Children must still be in the Center before 9:00 am to receive breakfast (after 9:00am, the teachers are generally in the middle of getting the field trip together, and it really puts us in a bind trying to make sure your child is fed and getting the field trip off as scheduled.)
- We must have a signed permission slip for all children to go on the field trip prior to loading the bus. Permission slips generally go out on Thursday of each week for the next week.

Pre-K Pre-Registration

We are now pre-registering for Pre-K for next school year.

The first day of school is August 11, 2008.

In order to hold a slot for Pre-K, we need a completed permission slip and a birth certificate. Additional documents needed at the beginning of Pre-K are:

- Social Security Card
- Certificate of Ear, Eye and Dental
- Immunizations on Form 3231 (Ready for School should be checked)

Pre-K hours are 8:30 am until 3:00 pm each day.

At Mother Hubbard's, the Pre-K Program includes not only day-to-day instruction based on State Standards but it also includes the following activities:

Breakfast, Lunch and Afternoon Snack

- Fall Festival (no cost)
- Parent's Thanksgiving Luncheon (no cost)
- Morning Transportation (free)
- Black History Program
- Holiday Program
- Award's Day Luncheon
- Family and Friends Day Program and outing
- Referrals for speech, developmental delays and behavior

Teachers in the Pre-K Program meet State Requirements and receive State Sponsored training each school year.
